



### Notes for November 21 event at Laguna Seca

1. Time. Arrive in time for the driver meeting and registration.
2. Food. The cafe at the track will be open with burgers and sandwiches. They do not take cash.
3. Car numbers. Please have legible car numbers on your car in a contrasting color. If you would like to purchase vinyl sticker numbers for your car for \$20, contact us.
4. Download meetings. There will be a quick download meeting 10 minutes after your first two sessions. All meetings and registration will be in the media building.
5. Passing:  
NOVICE/INTERMEDIATE. Front straight, between T4-T5, T5-T6, T6-T7. **Point by required.**  
ADVANCED/EXPERT. Open passing anywhere. **No race passing. Be cautious and courteous.**  
Race passing is anything sketchy that you would only do in a race situation.
6. Driving safely. 25 mph pit lane speed limit. 5 mph paddock speed limit.
7. Sound. The sound limit of 90dbA is enforced by the track and they mean it. Your day is done after two strikes if your car is too loud.
8. Flags. Know the flags and their meanings before you arrive to the track. Look on the FAQ section of the website.
9. Photos. There will be a photographer present at the event. Be sure to check out your photos after the event. Our photographer will be photographing the morning sessions and will have your photos live by the weekend. You can view your photos at:

10. Tip. It is best to arrive with a full tank of gas. You will use a lot during the day. Gas is available at the track, but is more expensive than at a gas station. Please do not run out of gas on the track or your day is over.
11. Track damage. You are responsible for any damage to the facility. If you spill oil on the track, you will get charged union rates for cleaning it up. If you hit a wall, you will be charged for replacing it.
12. Rain. We will run rain or shine. If it is wet, make sure your wipers work and you have appropriate tires. Wet Laguna Seca is a blast to drive.
13. Upon arrival at the front gate you will be met by a track employee who will ask you and your guests to sign a track waiver. There is no charge at the gate. After you are inside look for a place to park and set up for the day.
14. After you park, empty your car of all loose gear. You don't want anything inside the car that is not bolted down. The same goes for the trunk.
15. Nothing handheld in the car while on track please. If you have a passenger, tell them to keep hands inside and no holding a camera or things like that.
16. Check your event schedule for the time of all driver meetings and location. This may change due to circumstances but we try to keep on time.
17. Be ready to have fun.
